



Easter Basket Hunt Riddles

Directions: Print this page and cut out each riddle. Place inside a plastic Easter egg and hide eggs in places that match each riddle. It may help to number the backs of the riddles to keep track. You can put them in any order you like, but the final clue is meant for the kids to find their Easter baskets outside. (Of course, you could always use a different clue as the final one!) Have FUN!

We will hunt around the house. We will not go FAR. The next clue you will find inside of a C _ _ _.	My eggs are pink. My eggs are blue. On top of your sock, you put on your _ _ _ _!	Keep your eyes open. Do not even blink. To see the next clue, look in a S _ _ _!
Easter is fun! Easter is great! Go to the place where you get a plate!	Are these clues easy? Or are they hard? Go to the place where you'd find a credit card.	You are almost done. No more eggs for me to hide. To find your treat, go outside!

Riddle key (just in case you need help!)

From left to right:

ROW 1: Washing machine/laundry room, near a television,
near a toothbrush in the bathroom

ROW 2: In a bed, in the refrigerator, in a shower or bathtub

ROW 3: inside a car, inside a shoe, in a sink

ROW 4: on a plate in a cabinet, inside a purse or near a
wallet, your choice of location outside
